

## First Grade "How to" project (end of the year)







In writing, we have been discussing "How to" instructions to help us with descriptive details (writing with adjectives). The last project of first grade will be to do a presentation describing "How to \_\_\_\_\_". The possibilities are endless!

Examples:

- How to make a peanut butter and jelly sandwich
- How to kick a soccer ball
- How to tie your shoe
- How to add  $23 + 5$  on a number line
- How to take your dog for a walk

During the project, make sure you tell us what your project is. Use the words: first, next, then and last. Include details so we can follow along!

You can record directly from your phone, ipad, etc.</i></p>	 <p>Print photos or draw pictures of your step by step process of your "how to ____" and put it on a poster paper. Make sure to label the photos and write captions so we know what you are doing in each photo.</p>
 <p>In class presentation of "how to ____." Bring in any materials you need to present your project LIVE. <i>Keep presentation under 3 minutes.</i></p>	 <p>Create a powerpoint (with pictures) of your "how to ____". Make sure to include captions or be ready to tell us what you did in each picture. <i>Email powerpoint to your teacher with the subject line: "How to" powerpoint by (student name).</i></p>
